College of Engineering Pune, an Autonomous Institute of Government of Maharashtra has adopted credit based evaluation system. At the end of every semester, a student is awarded a Letter grade based on his / her performance in mid-semester, tests, / assignments / quizzes and end-semester examinations in every course registered by him / her. Institute has adopted a 10- point scale similar to the one followed in IITs. The description on the grades, grade points and divisions are as follows.

Grade	Grade Points	Range	Description of Performance
EX	10	91 to 100	Excellent
A	9	81 to 90	Very Good
B	8	71 to 80	Good
C	7	61 to 70	Fair
D	6	51 to 60	Average
E	5	40 to 50	Poor
FF	0	Below 40	Fail (Eligible for re-exam)

First Division with Distinction : CGPA \geq 7.5 and above
First Division : CGPA \geq 6.0 and $<$ 7.5
Second Division : CGPA \geq 5.0 and $<$ 6.0

SGPA is calculated based on the courses completed every semester. Similarly CGPA is calculated based on all the courses completed till that semester. Thus the CGPA is calculated on a scale of 10. **There is no Provision of Conversion of CGPA into Percentage of Marks.** However, for your purpose, you may treat the equivalence given by AICTE New Delhi as given in the below table as reference.

CGPA	Equivalent Percentage
8.25	75
7.75	70
7.25	65
6.75	60
6.25	55

Based on above table, the following formula is proposed to convert CGPA into Equivalent Percentage. This provision is applicable to the students admitted in first year from Academic Year 2003-04 to 2006-07.

Formula to convert CGPA into Equivalent Percentage of Marks:

Percentage of Marks: $[CGPA - 0.75] \times 10$
